Cooke City Long-Term Parking Area (Woody Creek) Sign-up The Forest Service is requesting residents that would like to park a vehicle in the Cooke City/Woody Creek parking area for a period of longer than 16 days to call or email Dave Green at 406-838-2007 or david.green1@usda.gov. Authorization is given by the Gardiner District Ranger on a case by case basis. Failure to get permission to park for longer than 16 days could result in a citation.

JUNK VEHICLE AREA: The county can only accept CARS, SUVs and PICKUPS. They must be drained of all gas, oil and antifreeze. The vehicles must be placed on the east side of the compactor building and the Northeast corner out of the way of traffic. They will need to have a registration or title with them or lic. plate. Things that can not be accepted are snowmobiles, iron of any sort , No trailers or camping trailers.
